Competition Authority Clears Acquisition of AMT-Sybex

The Competition Authority has today cleared the proposed acquisition by Rathcush Limited of sole control of AMT-Sybex Group Limited. The transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002 on 15 April 2014.

The Authority has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not lead to a substantial lessening of competition in any markets for goods or services in the State. The Authority will publish a public version of the reasons for its determination on its website (www.tca.ie) no later than 12 July 2014 after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information is removed from the published version.
