A.G. -v- Sandham and Gould.

DEPUTY BAILLIFF: "So are as Mr. Sandham is concerned we are going to dismiss the appeal, there is a long record of offences against the Road Traffic Laws, some serious some not so serious and in his case the remarks of the Magistrate are fully justified, there is irresponsibility and the Magistrate was quite justified in imposing a 3 months suspension, therefore the appeal is dismissed.

So far as Mrs. Gould is concerned, we think, as I say, we should distinguish between her sentence and that of Mr. Sandham because her record is nothing like as long although, in her own words, she is equally responsible - we think the proper sentence for her is 1 month's disqualification and therefore we allow her appeal in part.
