DEPUTY BAILIFF: With regard to the contempt alleged in the Representation of the 23rd January, 1987, of the Autorisés, the Court notes that Mr. Benest is prepared to advise the Autorisés not to pursue the matter. In the circumstances, the Court does not propose to take any further action in the matter.

The regard to Order 3 of the 26th January, 1987, for the accounting of income from 4 St Saviour's Crescent, the Court adjourns the consideration of the defendant's contempt of that Order to another day.

With regard to Order 5 of the 26th January, 1987, about the keys of 4 St Saviour's Crescent, the Court, having regard to the further orders made today, does not propose to take any further action.

The Court declares that, in accordance with the terms the Loi 1839, Sur les Remises de Biens, the whole of the costs of the Autorisés shall be payable out of the assets in the 'remise'.
