Judgment

The Bailiff: (indistinct) but you have got try to help yourself. We understand the difficulties you face but you have the support of your father and of the Probation Office and you can turn to both of them if you want advice and help at anytime, we know that, but unless you persevere in this problem of drink and undertake carefully and fully the course which will be proposed to you by the psychiatrists you may find yourself in trouble again, and if you do this sort of thing again you have heard what the Attorney General has said, next time he will ask if it comes up here for a sentence of imprisonment. I am not going to say that we will impose it, but the Attorney will ask for it, and it may well be that you will be sentenced to imprisonment, and really you have had a few chances and you have shown that you can adapt and we hope that you will be able to do so. You are placed on probation for two years. ✓
