Deputy Bailiff: "The Court is entirely satisfied that this was a sham and a deliberate transaction and that steps were taken to put it right only after it had been found out. The Court has no hesitations whatsoever in granting the conclusions of the Solicitor General therefore Mr. Alton is fined one thousand two hundred and fifty pounds (£1,250.) or, in default of payment, will serve five months imprisonment. Miss Lynch is fined seven hundred and fifty pounds (£750.) or, in default of payment, will serve three months imprisonment and both defendants are jointly and severally ordered to pay costs in the sum of two hundred and fifty pounds (£250.) (Two weeks to pay fines and costs).
