**JUDGMENT**

THE BAILIFF: We are going to grant the conclusions of the Solicitor General. What you both did was very wrong. We understand the reason you did it, Burgess, but nevertheless you just cannot go helping yourself to other peoples' money. You must know that, and neither, Le Clezio, should you have assisted him. But under the circumstances we are going to grant the conclusions as I have said. You are both placed on one year's probation with the usual conditions which are: to live and work as directed by the probation officer, if that is necessary and to be of good behaviour during this period

and to come up for sentence should you reoffend again. You, Burgess, will do 120 hours community service as a condition of your probation. You, Le Clezio, will do 90 hours of community service as a condition of your probation.
