JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: The Court cannot resurrect this company for the simple reason that this application is on all fours with your previous application to resurrect Salvors International Limited, and that failed. You went all the way to the Court of Appeal, Mr. Woolley, and the Court of Appeal ruled quite clearly that the Royal Court was right in refusing that application. It would be totally inconsistent of us to grant your application this afternoon, a similar application having previously gone all the way to the Court of Appeal. And therefore, while sympathising with you, I am afraid that we must refuse your application.
