**JUDGMENT**

THE BAILIFF: I do not think it is necessary for your defence for you to be at liberty. The circumstances really require you to remain in prison until the question of your case can be cleared up as quickly as possible. We advise you most strongly to agree to have an advocate allocated to you and to see the psychiatrist; I really think you should, but I cannot force you. Bail is refused.
