JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The Court grants the conclusions of the Attorney General.

Therefore Mr. Le Couillard is fined the sum of £400, or in default of payment he would have to go to prison for two months. I presume that will be no difficulty because there is bail of £500, and the fine can be deducted from the bail money.

We also order that the string of pots seized by the Jersey officers will be forfeited and we order that Mr. Le Couillard will pay costs in the sum of £200.
