Breach of Probation Order imposed on 10th July, 1992, (see Jersey Unreported Judgment of that date).

Previous Breach of Probation Order brought before Court on 27th November, 1992 (see Jersey Unreported Judgment of that date).

On 10th July, 1992, the accused had pleaded guilty to:

2 counts of	malicious damage. (Counts 1 and 2 of original Indictment).
1 count of	assault. (Count 3).
1 count of	having received, hidden or withheld property knowing it to have been stolen. (Count 4).

CONCLUSIONS:

Count 1: 5 months' imprisonment.
Count 2: 3 months' imprisonment (concurrent).
Count 3: 3 months' imprisonment (concurrent).
Count 4: 3 months' imprisonment (consecutive).

SENTENCE:

Conclusions granted.

JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: Howard, you have heard what your counsel has said and you have heard what the Crown Advocate has said and really you have been given every chance. You were warned last time what might happen if you broke your probation which has now happened twice. We have given you all the chances we can and we cannot find that the conclusions asked for are wrong. You are therefore sentenced in accordance with the conclusions to a total of eight months' imprisonment.
