Application by the Plaintiff for an Acte à de prison

On 4th March, 1993, the Judicial Greffier, in relation to the Plaintiff's application for summary judgment, and pursuant to Rule 7/1(1) of the Royal Court Rules 1992, ordered the Defendant to pay the Plaintiff:

- (1) The sum of £19,338.82;
- (2) Interest at the rate of 17% per annum upon the said sum of £19,338.82 from the 1st December, 1992, until the date of payment; and
- (3) The taxed costs of the Plaintiff in the original action. (The sum of £1,490.16 being quantified on taxation).

JUDGMENT

THE LIEUTENANT BAILIFF: This is an application for an Acte à peine de prison contested by the Defendant.

It was accepted before us by the Plaintiff that the Court had a discretion as to whether to grant the Act. Counsel for the Plaintiff urged that the Plaintiff is entitled to her Act and that the onus is upon the Defendant to satisfy the Court that the Order should not be granted, see <u>Bianchi -v- Gentile</u> (12th July, 1990) Jersey Unreported at p. 2:

"The granting of an Acte à peine de prison is discretionary and it is not obligatory upon the Court to do so if it satisfied that the Defendant is making strenuous efforts to repay the amount.

We are satisfied these efforts are being made by the Gentili family."

10 We think that is correct but even if the *onus*is the other way we would still have no hesitation in granting
the Act on the evidence before us. The consistent failure of Mr.
Benest to give either proper information, or to take reasonable
steps to meet the Plaintiff's claim, together with his evidence
which we found to be less that satisfactory, disqualify him from
the relief which he claims.

The Acte à peine de prison is granted.
