**The Sunninghill Gardens, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2010**

Made - - - - *5th October 2010*

Coming into operation - *24th November 2010*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (3) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 8 to, the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes, on completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic, to stop-up Sunninghill Gardens, Belfast to vehicular traffic at the line specified in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

One objection was received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Sunninghill Gardens, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 24th November 2010.

(2) In this Order “the developer” means Clanmil Housing Association whose registered address is Northern Whig House, 3 Waring Street, Belfast, BT1 2DX.

Application

2.—(1) The developer shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of the works Sunninghill Gardens, Belfast shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the line specified in the Schedule.

(2) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as it thinks fit, access to the road by vehicular traffic.
