**The Redpoll Avenue, Lisburn (Footpaths) (Abandonment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2010**

Made - - - - *22nd December 2010*

Coming into operation - *23rd February 2011*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the area of road described in the Schedule is not necessary for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Redpoll Avenue, Lisburn (Footpaths) (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 23rd February 2011.

Application

2. The area of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be removed.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be extinguished.
