**The Seed Potatoes (Tuber Inspection Fees) (Amendment)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *11th March 2011*

*Coming into operation* - *1st September 2011*

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (a), in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b), after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to it to be concerned, makes the following Regulations:

**Title and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Seed Potatoes (Tuber Inspection Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 1st September 2011.

**Amendment of The Seed Potatoes (Tuber Inspection Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006**

2. For the Schedule to The Seed Potatoes (Tuber Inspection Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011 substitute:

**“SCHEDULE** regulation 2

The Regulations increase the seed potatoes tuber inspection fees from £4.40 per tonne or part thereof to £4.80 per tonne or part thereof from 1st September 2011.
