**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment  
No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *15th December 2014*

*Coming into operation* - *5th January 2015*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representations have been received.

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 5th January 2015.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2 (3)

### Unlimited Waiting

- “1039. Cedar Avenue, Belfast (north side) – from a point 53 metres east of its junction with Cavehill Road, for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction.
- 1040. Fernwood Street, Belfast (west side) – from a point 55 metres south of its junction with Blackwood Street, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 1041. Larkfield Gardens, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 81 metres south-east of its junction with Larkfield Drive, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 1042. Oberon Street, Belfast (north side) – from a point 47 metres west of its junction with Willowholme Drive, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
- 1043. Victoria Crescent, Lisburn (north-east side) – from a point 69 metres north-west of its junction with New Street, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 1044. The Promenade, Portstewart (west side) – from a point 140 metres north-west of its junction with The Crescent, for a distance of 13 metres in a north-westerly direction.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule and the removal of the parking places referred to in Articles 2(2) and 3(2).
