**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment  
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016**

*Made* - - - - - *15th July 2016*

*Coming into operation* - *8th August 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

Five written objections have been received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 8th August 2016.

**Amendments**

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016<sup>(d)</sup> is amended by the addition to Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the following item—

“10. Sydenham Road access road (west side) – from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Sydenham Road for a distance of 182 metres in a southerly direction.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 (“the Order”) by the addition of a no waiting at any time restriction on the length of road specified in Article 2. Vehicles are excepted from the restriction in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
