**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment
No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016**

Made - - - - - *20th December 2016*

Coming into operation - *16th January 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 16th January 2017.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016^(d) is amended by the addition to Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the following items—

- “61. East Bridge Street (south side) - from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Mays Meadow for a distance of 145 metres in a westerly direction.
- 62. East Bridge Street (south side) - from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Stewart Street for a distance of 83 metres in an easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 (“the Order”) by the addition to Part 1 of Schedule 2 of the items specified in Article 2.

The Order prohibits vehicles waiting on the lengths of road specified in Article 2 at any time.

Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
