**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019**

*Made - - - - 18th June 2019*

*Coming into operation 16th July 2019*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(1)</sup>, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(7A)(b) of the Road Races (Northern Ireland) Order 1986<sup>(2)</sup> and now exercisable by it<sup>(3)</sup>, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf makes the following Regulations.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 16th July 2019.

**Charges**

2. The maximum charge for a spectator badge in respect of each person shall be £30.00.

**Revocation**

3. The Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2011<sup>(4)</sup> are revoked.
