**The Parking Places, Loading Bay and Waiting Restrictions
(Downpatrick) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019**

Made - - - - - *17th July 2019*

Coming into operation - *7th August 2019*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places, Loading Bay and Waiting Restrictions (Downpatrick) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 7th August 2019.

Amendment

2. Schedule 3 to The Parking Places, Loading Bay and Waiting Restrictions (Downpatrick) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017^(d) is amended by the addition of the following item—

“12. English Street (south-east side) – from a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Mount Crescent for a distance of 4 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places, Loading Bay and Waiting Restrictions (Downpatrick) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 (“the Order”) by the addition of a no waiting at any time restriction on a length of English Street, Downpatrick as specified in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
