ROAD TRAFFIC

The A76 Trunk Road (Sanquhar) (Restricted Road) Order 2010

Made *13th August 2010*

Coming into force *23rd August 2010*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(b), 83(1) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(**b**).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A76 Trunk Road (Sanquhar) (Restricted Road) Order 2010 and comes into force on 23rd August 2010.

Restricted road

2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road with a speed limit of 30mph for the purposes of section 81(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Variation of previous Order

3. The Dumfries - Kilmarnock Trunk Road (A76) (Sanquhar and Thornhill) (Restricted Roads) Order 1992(a) is hereby varied to the effect that paragraph 2 of the Schedule to that Order is revoked.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A76 Dumfries-Kilmarnock Trunk Road at Sanquhar from a point 44 metres or thereby north west of its junction with Castlemains Road (U431) to a point 338 metres or thereby north west of its junction with Blackaddie Road (C128), for a distance of 1521 metres or thereby.
