ROAD TRAFFIC

The M77/A77 Trunk Road (Junction 2 (Barrhead Road) to Plantation) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Coming into force

3rd September 2010
16th September 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act they are satisfied that, because of the likelihood of danger to the public, the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order should be restricted or prohibited.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M77/A77 Trunk Road (Junction 2 (Barrhead Road) to Plantation) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010, comes into force at 0930 hours on 16th September 2010 and ceases to have effect at 0500 hours on 17th September 2010.

Temporary prohibition on use of a road

2. Use of the lengths of road specified in the schedule, by pedestrians or by vehicle, is prohibited.

Exception for emergency and other traffic

3. Article 2 does not apply to-

- (a) use in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

(b) use by pedestrians or by vehicles in accordance with the permission and direction of a police constable in uniform (including such permission and direction as may be indicated from time to time by means of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a)).

SCHEDULE**Articles 2 and 3**

1. That length of the northbound M77/A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road from a point immediately to the north of the northbound off-slip road at Junction 2 (Barrhead Road) to the M8/A8 Edinburgh - Greenock Trunk Road Junction 22 (Plantation), a distance of 5.26 kilometres or thereby.
2. That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road being the northbound on-slip road at Junction 2 (Barrhead Road), a distance of 300 metres or thereby.
3. That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road being the northbound off-slip road at Junction 1 (Dumbreck), a distance of 343 metres or thereby.
4. That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road being the northbound on-slip road at Junction 1 (Dumbreck), a distance of 270 metres or thereby.
5. That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road being the southbound off-slip road at Junction 1 (Dumbreck), a distance of 482 metres or thereby.
