**The A96 Trunk Road (Ashgrove Road, Elgin) (Temporary
Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2011**

Made
Coming into force

21st September 2011
1st October 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Ashgrove Road, Elgin) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2011, comes into force on 1st October 2011 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 30th October 2011.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 612 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991, Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Permission or direction of Police Constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

PART 1

That length of the A96 Aberdeen - Inverness Trunk Road at its junction with Ashgrove Road, Elgin.

PART 2

All right turns from the eastbound A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road to Ashgrove Road, Elgin.
