ROAD TRAFFIC

The A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Bridge) (Temporary Bus Lane) Order 2015

Made - - - - *19th February 2015*

Coming into force - - *27th February 2015*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Bridge) (Temporary Bus Lane) Order 2015, comes into force on 27th February 2015 and ceases to have effect on 10th April 2015.

Interpretation

2. In this order “bus” is defined in regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

Bus lane

3. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle other than a bus, to enter, proceed, or wait within the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order, when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 616 and 954 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemptions

4. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road from a point 390 metres or thereby south of its junction with the A977 Longannet Roundabout – Gartarry Roundabout Trunk Road southwards to its junction with the A985 Kincardine – Rosyth Trunk Road, a distance of 14 metres or thereby.
