**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A82 Trunk Road (Drumnadrochit and Lewiston) (30mph  
Speed Limit) Order 2018**

*Made* - - - - 25th September 2018

*Coming into force* - - 1st October 2018

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Drumnadrochit and Lewiston) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2018 and comes into force on 1st October 2018.

**Speed restriction**

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

**Revocation**

3. The A82 (Drumnadrochit and Lewiston) (30mph and 40mph speed limit) Order 2006(d) is revoked.

**Exemption**

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 180 metres or thereby east of the extended east gable of the Visitors Centre, Drumnadrochit Hotel, westwards, then southwards, then southeastwards, to a point 215 metres or thereby east of the extended front elevation of Borlum Bridge Cottage, Lewiston, a distance of 1.865 kilometres or thereby.
