7. Comments (optional)

I am satisfied that the Complainant has Rights, in particular unregistered rights, in the Disputed Domain Name, as shown, *inter alia*, by the website http://www.mglgroup.co.uk/rainton-construction/. The Expert further finds, on balance, that given the nature of the Disputed Domain Name and the fact that it has been used by the Complainant for its construction business for a significant number of years, the Respondent was likely aware of the Complainant's Rights and registered the Disputed Domain Name to take advantage of such Rights. The fact that the Complainant appears to have allowed the Disputed Domain Name to lapse inadvertently does not mean that the Respondent has any right to register or use it, especially when the Disputed Domain Name could cause confusion amongst internet users as to it source.

8. Decision

I grant the Complainant's application for a summary decision. In accordance with section 12 of the Policy, the Disputed Domain Name will therefore be transferred to the Complainant.
