DETERMINATION AND REASONS

- 1. This is an appeal to the Upper Tribunal, with permission, by the Appellant with regard to a decision of the First-tier Tribunal (Judge E M M Smith) promulgated on 24th March 2015 by which it dismissed her appeal against the Secretary of State's decision to refuse to vary her leave to remain as a Tier 4 (General) Student Migrant and/or on Article 8 grounds.
- 2. The appeal was dealt with on the papers at the Appellant's request. She had paid the fee appropriate for a paper hearing.
- 3. The Judge indicated that no further evidence had been received from the Appellant. However the file contains a bundle of documents provided to the Tribunal by the Appellant which was marked as having been received by the Tribunal on 19th March; before the appeal was determined.
