**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND**

**REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT**

1. By way of a letter dated 3 December 2015 the appellant has requested that his case be treated as withdrawn by the Upper Tribunal.
2. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and observing that the appellant was the successful party before the First-tier Tribunal, that decision has now been set aside.
