JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's complaint and unlawful deductions from wages relating to the national minimum wage is dismissed.
2. The Claimant's complaint of breach of contract relating to notice succeeds and she is awarded the agreed sum of £1,004.40 in compensation, but subject to an increase of 20% under s. 207A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992, being a total of £1,205.28.
3. The Claimant is further awarded costs in accordance with rule 76 (4) of the Employment Tribunal (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 in the sum of £390, representing the fees paid by her in relation to her Type A claim which succeeded, in accordance with the Employment Tribunals and Employment Appeal Tribunal Fees Order 2013.
