JUDGMENT

The judgment of the tribunal is:

1. The Claimant's application to amend his claim to rely on the allegations of race discrimination (direct discrimination and harassment) set out in his Further Details of Claim filed on 30 November 2017 is refused. The Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear such claims as they are out of time and it is not considered to be just and equitable to extend time; and
2. The claim for race discrimination is struck out on the basis that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
3. The Respondent's application for a Deposit Order is refused.
