AND having heard the parties on the issue of remedy:

The respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the claimant in respect of disability discrimination, on or before 27 March 2017, calculated as follows:

Injury to feelings	£1,250.00
Interest thereon (8% for 7 months)	75.00
Loss of earnings (4.5 months at £935)	4,207.50
Interest thereon (4% for 7 months on £3272.50)	<u>130.90</u>

Total award **£5,663.40**

The Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 provides that sums of money payable as a result of a judgment of an Employment Tribunal (excluding sums representing costs or expenses), shall carry interest where the full amount is not paid within 14 days after the day that the document containing the tribunal's written judgment is recorded as having been sent to parties. That day is known as "*the relevant decision day*". The date from which interest starts to accrue is called "*the calculation day*" and is the day immediately following the relevant decision day.

The rate of interest payable is that specified in section 17 of the Judgments Act 1838 on the relevant decision day. This is known as "the stipulated rate of interest" and the rate applicable in your case is set out below.
