JUDGMENT

Neither respondent having presented a response nor appeared at the hearing the tribunal makes the following judgment.

- 1. It is declared that the claimant was employed by the Second Respondent.
- 2. The First Respondent is dismissed from the proceedings.
- 3. The claimant's claim against the Second Respondent in respect of unpaid wages is well-founded.
- 4. The Second Respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the claimant as follows:

4.1. in respect of unpaid wages £320.63

4.2. in respect of losses caused by the failure to pay wages £100.00

5. The claimant's application for a preparation time order is granted. The Second Respondent is further ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £570 in respect of preparation time.

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6. For the avoidance of doubt the total sum payable under this judgment is £990.63.
