## JUDGMENT ON PRELIMINARY HEARING

1. The claim of failure to provide payslips is dismissed on withdrawal by claimant.
2. The claim of detriment for raising a protected disclosure is dismissed as having been received out of time and the tribunal therefore having no jurisdiction to determine it.
3. In the event the claim had not been struck out on that basis, the tribunal would have struck it out as disclosing no reasonable cause of action.
4. Further and in the alternative, had the claim not been struck out on that basis, the tribunal would have ordered a deposit to be paid the claim having little reasonable prospect of success.
