JUDGMENT

Made under rule 37 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

- 1. The claims for Unfair Dismissal and for a Redundancy Payment are struck out.
- 2. The claims for Unpaid Wages and Notice Pay will proceed to be served on the Respondent.

REASONS

- 1. On 14 November 2018 the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant to inform him that an Employment Judge was considering striking out his claims for Unfair Dismissal and for a Redundancy Payment because he did not have the necessary 2 years' length of service and does not appear to have been made Redundant. He was given until 21 November 2018 to object to the proposal or to request a hearing at which to do so.
- 2. The Claimant has failed to respond to the Tribunal's letter. The claims for Unfair Dismissal and for a Redundancy Payment are therefore struck out because they have no reasonable prospect of success.
- 3. The claims for Unpaid Wages and Notice Pay will proceed to be served on the Respondent.
