JUDGMENT

The claimant is not a person with a disability within the meaning of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010.

REASONS

1. On 12th October 2018, following an in person Preliminary Hearing, this matter was listed for a preliminary hearing to be heard on 17th December 2018 to deal with the question as to whether the claimant was a disabled person within the meaning of s.6 Equality Act 2010 by reason of "workplace contact dermatitis".

2. Neither party attended the preliminary hearing before me today. I waited until 10.15am and then asked the clerk to make contact with the parties. This proved to be unsuccessful.
3. As such I put the case back in case the parties attended the Tribunal late and dealt with another case in the interim. At 2.30pm I checked with the clerk and there had still been no contact from either party nor had anyone attended the Tribunal.
4. In the absence of any evidence on file in support of the claimant's disability I determine that the claimant is not a person with a disability pursuant to section 6 of the Equality Act.
