JUDGMENT

The complaints that the claimants were unfairly dismissed is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimants complain of unfair dismissal.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 3. The claimants were employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimants are not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The claimants have failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaints should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaints of unfair dismissal are struck out. The claimants' other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
- 7. The hearing listed and 3 and 4 July 2019 is vacated. It will be replaced by a **2 hour** hearing at **10 am on 3 July at Bristol Employment Tribunal**.
