## **JUDGMENT**

### **Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013**

The judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that the claimant`s complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages succeeds and the respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £200.

## **REASONS**

1. A copy of the claim form setting out the claimant`s complaint was sent to the respondent on 13 November 2018.
2. In accordance with the terms of Rule 16 of the Rules to be found in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 the respondent was required to enter a response within twenty eight days of the date on which a copy of the claim was sent to it but failed to do so.
3. The Employment Judge decided that on the available material a determination could properly be made without a hearing.
4. The remedy to which the claimant is entitled for the claim totals £200.
