## **JUDGMENT**

It is the unanimous decision of the Tribunal that:

- 1. The claimant's direct discrimination claim fails and is dismissed.
- 2. The Respondent's policy of not reducing its hours targets for annual bonuses to reflect time spent on holiday ("the PCP") did put women at a particular disadvantage when compared with men. However, the respondent was able to show that PCP to be a proportionate means of achieving a legitimate aim.
