## JUDGMENT

The claim against Lyndon-Dykes Limited is struck out.

## REASONS

1. The first respondent company is in compulsory liquidation. The permission of the court has not been obtained for these proceedings to be instituted or continued as required by the Insolvency Act 1986.
2. On 17 November 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons within 14 days why the claim against the first respondent company should not be struck out as it had not been actively pursued. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason.
3. The claim against Lyndon-Dykes Limited is, therefore, struck out.
4. This judgment does not affect the claim against Oak Country Club Limited.
