JUDGMENT

The following claims brought by the claimant re struck out as having no reasonable prospects of success:

1. the claim for breach of contract;
2. the claim for sex discrimination; and
3. the claims of discrimination on the grounds of (1) race and (2) religion and belief in relation to the following alleged acts of less favourable treatment:
 - a. the allegation the respondent failed to assist the claimant by reimbursing him wholly or in part in respect of a fine and a loss of wages incurred by him as a result of driving without insurance in or around late February 2020;

- b. the allegation that around April 2020, a manager at the store (Bilal), publicly interrogated the claimant and searched through his car; and
- c. the allegation that a female colleague (Karolina) splashed cleaning fluid on the claimant in front of a manager (Rachel) and nothing was done about it.
