## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the tribunal is as follows:

1. The claimant was an employee of the respondent.
2. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions in respect of arrears of pay succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £884.48 gross.
3. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions in respect of holiday pay succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £615.75 gross.
4. The claimant's claim for breach of contract (expenses) succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £250.74 gross.

5. The claimant's claim for breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay) succeeds and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £54.58 gross.
6. The claimant is entitled to a payment as a result of the respondent's failure to provide a written statement of particulars of employment. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant two weeks' pay of £109.16 gross.
7. In total, the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant £1914.71 gross.
