**JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL**

1. The Judgment of the Tribunal is that the claimant is due to be paid £210 (Two Hundred and Ten Pounds) by the respondents in respect of wages due to him. (One Hundred and Ninety Pounds) and travelling expenses, (Twenty Pounds). The respondents are ordered to pay the said amount of Two Hundred and Ten Pounds to the claimant.
