JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

1. The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

a. The claim for holiday pay against the first respondent is well-founded and the first respondent is ordered to pay the sum of **£52.66** (0.5 weeks x £261 gross/week which totals £130.50 less the sum of £77.84 already paid to the claimant), subject to deduction of income tax and national insurance.

b. The claim for holiday pay against the second respondent is not well-founded and is dismissed.

- c. The claim for holiday pay against the third respondent is not well-founded and is dismissed.
