JUDGMENT

- The Claimant's in respect of an unlawful deduction from his wages in respect of mileage is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The Claimant's claim in respect of an unlawful deductions of wages for unpaid holiday pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. At the point of the hearing the Respondent had failed to provide the Claimant with a statement of main terms and conditions of employment, contrary to section 1 Employment Rights Act 1996.

Remedy

- 4. The Respondent will pay the Claimant the sum of £795.20 in respect of unpaid mileage.
- 5. The Respondent will pay the Claimant the sum of £239.61, which is two weeks average pay, as compensation under section 38 Employment Act 2002.

Therefore, the total sum now payable to the Claimant by the Respondent is £1034.81
