## **Basic Award**

- Weekly wage =  $42 \times £28 = £1176$  (Limited to statutory cap of £700)
- 5 years service over the age of 41 = 5 x 1.5 = 7 weeks
- 7 weeks @ £700 = **£4900.00**
- Contributory conduct reduction of 75%

Total Basic Award = £1225.00

- 4. I make no compensatory award as the claimant had no loss in consequence of the dismissal.
- 5. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £1225.00
