JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages contrary to s13 Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded. The Respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's pay in January 2024. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the net sum of £1,506.84 deducted from his pay.
- 2. The Respondent has no basis for recovery of any shortfall in training costs, any attempts at recovery contravening s15 Employment Rights Act 1996.
