JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages under section 13 Employment Rights Act 1996 is well founded.
2. The claimant was entitled to be paid the National Minimum Wage for the period of time he worked for the respondent between August 2023 and April 2024.
3. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£9,738.38 (gross)**.
