Upon the claimant's reference to the Employment Tribunal made pursuant to section 11(1) of the Employment Rights Act 1996:

- 1. The following particulars ought to have been included in the statement of initial employment particulars:
 - 1.1. The names of the respondent and of the claimant as the employer and the worker respectively.
 - 1.2. That the claimant's employment began on 17 July 2023.
 - 1.3. The claimant's gross annual wage was £52,000 per annum and was £39,401.50 per annum net, payable monthly.
 - 1.4. The claimant's holiday entitlement was 28 days per annum including public holidays.
- 2. The respondent failed to give the claimant written itemised pay statements as required by Section 8 of the 1996 Act for the period of the claimant's employment between 17 July 2023 and 1 March 2024.
