

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

Date: 27 April 2017

Public Authority: Dudley and West Midlands Zoological Society

Limited

Address: Castle Hill, Dudley, DY1 4QF

Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 1. The complainant has requested information relating to various job titles and departments at Dudley and West Midlands Zoological Society Limited (DWMZS).
- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that DWMZS is a public authority for the purposes of FOIA pursuant to section 6 of the FOIA.
- 3. DWMZS should now issue a response to the complainant ensuring it complies with section 17¹, of the FOIA.

Request and response

4. On 20 December 2016, the complainant wrote to DWMZS and requested information in the following terms:

"I am writing to make a request for information about Dudley Zoo under Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The information that I request is as follows:

1. The job titles (but not the names of the actual post-holders) of the members of the Zoo's senior management team.

- 2. A list of the departments of Dudley Zoo and the job title (but not the names of the actual post-holders) of the head of each department.
- 3. A list of the names of the animal sections (or other similar divisions) into which the department that manages the Zoo's animal collection is divided.
- 4. A list of the job titles (but not the names of the actual post-holders) of staff in the department that manages the Zoo's animal collection, specifically curatorial and zookeeping staff."
- 5. DWMZS responded on 21 December 2016 and stated that as a registered charity it was not subject to FOIA.
- 6. The complainant responded the same day and stated:
 - "Dudley and West Midlands Zoological Society Ltd is a company which has a share capital. All shares in Dudley and West Midlands Zoological Society Ltd are owned by Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council. That makes Dudley and West Midlands Zoological Society Ltd a publicly owned company. Section 6 of the Act applies and you are bound by this legislation."
- 7. DWMZS responded on 24 December 2016 and maintained that it was not subject to FOIA.

Scope of the case

- 8. The complainant contacted the Commissioner on 8 March 2017 to complain about the way his request for information had been handled.
- 9. The Commissioner considers the scope of this case to be to determine if DWMZS is a public authority for the purposes of FOIA.

Reasons for decision

10. The relevant sections of the FOIA are:

Section 3(1)(b) which states:

- (1) In this Act "public authority" means—
- (b) a publicly-owned company as defined by section 6.

Section 6 - Publicly-owned companies



- (1) A company is a "publicly-owned company" for the purposes of section 3(1)(b) if—
- (b) it is wholly owned by any public authority (amended to "the wider public sector") listed in Schedule 1

For the purposes of this section—

- (b) a company is wholly owned by the wider public sector if, and only if, every member is a person falling within sub-paragraph (i) or (ii)—
- (i) a relevant public authority or a company wholly owned by the wider public sector,
- 11. Schedule 1 Part II defines a local authority as:

A local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1972, namely—

- (a) in England, a county council, a London borough council, a district council or a parish council,
- 12. The Commissioner has reviewed the information provided to her by the complainant along with publically available information via Companies House. She has also considered her own guidance⁴.
- 13. DWMZS's annual return dated 22 June 2016 shows that all its shares are held by Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council, i.e. a public authority.

Conclusion

14. The Commissioner's decision is that DWMZ is indeed a public authority for the purposes of FOIA.
