

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Decision notice

Date: 7 July 2022

Public Authority: Ministry of Justice Address: 102 Petty France

London SW1H 9AJ

Decision (including any steps ordered)

- 1. The complainant made a request for information relating deprivation of a person's British citizenship. The request was made on 21 January 2022 and the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) has failed to provide a response.
- 2. The Commissioner considers that the MOJ has breached section 10 FOIA in the handling of this request.
- 3. The Commissioner requires the public authority to take the following steps to ensure compliance with the legislation.
 - Provide a response to the request in compliance with FOIA.
- 4. The public authority must take these steps within 35 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of the Act and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

Request and response

5. On 21 January 2022 the complainant made the following request for information under the FOIA for:

"Please provide the following information:

- The number of cases related to deprivation of a person's British citizenship under the British Nationality Act 1981 in each year from 2000 to 2021 (inclusive).
- For each year's data, please indicate whether these were challenges to the deprivation decision at the Special Immigration



Appeals Tribunal or an appeal of a decision from that Tribunal, or other form of challenge.

- For each type of challenge, please indicate the number of cases that ended in favour of the person challenging a decision to have their citizenship deprived.
- For each type of challenge, please indicate the number of cases in which the Secretary of State for the Home Department was named as a party (and whether appellant or defendant). Please divide this by year for the same time period indicated above."
- 6. The MoJ has failed to provide a response to this request.

Scope of the case

- 7. The complainant contacted the Commissioner on 1 June 2022 and asked him to investigate whether the MoJ had complied with section 10 FOIA in the handling of this request.
- 8. The Commissioner has considered whether the MoJ complied with section 10 FOIA in this case.

Reasons for decision

Section 10

9. Section 10(1) provides that:

"Subject to subsections (2) and (3), a public authority must comply with section 1(1) promptly and in any event not later than the twentieth working day following the date of receipt."

10. Section 1(1) provides that:

"Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled –

- (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
- (b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to him."
- 11. The request was made on 21 January 2022 and the MoJ has failed to respond to the request. This is despite the Commissioner contacting the MoJ on 11 June 2022 to remind it of its obligations under FOIA to respond to the request. The Commissioner therefore finds that the MoJ



breached section 10(1) FOIA in failing to provide a response to this request.



Right of appeal

12. Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from: First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights)
