IN THE MATTER OF an application under
Section 13(1) by John Patrick Darcy in respect
of Patent application Nos GB 0009785.7 and
GB 0019922.4 in the name of John Patrick Darcy

DECISION

- 1 Patent application Nos GB 0009785.7 and GB 0019922.4 were originally filed in the name of Timothy Armitage. John Patrick Darcy was registered as the patent applicant in place of Timothy Armitage by virtue of an assignment.
- 2 John Patrick Darcy has now applied to be mentioned as a joint inventor in accordance with Section 13(1) of the Act.
- 3 Timothy Armitage has confirmed in writing that he supports John Patrick Darcy's request to be named as a joint inventor. I therefore conclude that the relevant party in this matter agrees that John Patrick Darcy was a joint inventor.
- 4 Accordingly I find that John Patrick Darcy should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the patent applications and any patents granted for the inventions.
